### *Schedule of Events*

**1-4-06 Sacramento Chess Club G/10 Championship Qualifier.** 5 round Swiss. This will be the qualifying round for the championship to be held on 1-11. The format will be as follows: If there are 21 or more entries, there will be three ratings balanced sections with the top two advancing to the finals from each section; if there are 20 or fewer entries, there will be two ratings balanced sections with the top three scores from each section advancing to the finals. Ties for advancement to the finals will be broken with a G/5 playoff. Registration 6:30-6:50. Games start at 6:55. Entry fee \$5. USCF Quick Chess rated.

**1-11 Sacramento Chess Club G/10 Championship.** The title will be determined by a six-player round robin with the qualifiers from 1-4. Any ties for the title will be broken using a G/10 playoff. USCF Quick Chess rated. Games start at 7.

**2-22>?? Sacramento Chess Club Team Championship.** Round Robin. 6 person teams. No team may have more than 3 alternates. The average rating for any given night may not exceed 1750. For purposes of calculating the adjusted ratings, any player rated over 2200 will count as 2200; any player rated under 1300 and unrated players will count as 1300. Ratings will be based on the February 2005 Supplement. We encourage other clubs, schools, employers, or fraternities to field teams. Clever names, logos, t-shirts, mascots, fight songs, etc., are all encouraged. No need to be subtle. If you can't find

a team, contact Cain Garrett, Bob Baker, or Steve Bickford at the Club, call John McCumiskey at 524-9479, or send an e-mail to us. You will be placed in a competitive situation as quickly as possible. Time control will be Game 55 d/5 or Game 60. USCF rated. Entry fee \$30 per team. Lineups must be placed in rating order. With TD approval, unrated players may be placed anywhere in the lineup, however, they must always play in the rating range of the players above and below them (i.e., if board 2 is rated 1904, board 4 is rated 1748, and an unrated player is placed on board 3, the unrated player must always be on a board between players rated from 1748 to 1904). Trophy for the members of the winning team and best board score. (To win a board prize, a player must play 60% of the available games on that board. For example, if there are 5 games in the event, a player must play 3 games on a board to win the board prize.) We would like to see six to eight teams for this event! All rounds start at 6:55 pm.

## 2006 Sacramento Elementary School Championship, January 28, 2006

**SECTIONS:** K – 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade; K – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade; K – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade; K – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade. For example, a 4<sup>th</sup> grade student may play in the K-6, K-8, or K-12 sections, but not the K-3 section, while a 9<sup>th</sup> grade student may only play in the K-12 section. A team event will be held in each section (a team is a minimum of two students from a school or club in a section).

**LOCATION:** James R Cowan Fundamental School, 3350 Becerra Way, Sacramento. Directions: From Interstate 80 or Business Loop 80 in Sacramento, exit on Watt Avenue and go south. Go approximately one mile and turn left on Whitney Avenue. Go approximately ¾ mile and turn right on Becerra Way. The school is a ½ mile down the road on the left.

**GENERAL INFO:** All players must be current members of the United States Chess Federation (USCF). Non-members may join when they send in their entry. The event will be run according to the USCF rule book and any modifications made for scholastic competition.
